

Salt water fly fishing. Jerry Wood has fished all over the country and shared with us his adventures with his sons of the coast of Florida, in the Mangroves, and in the Keys. He talked about great fishing stories and shared some advice on clothing, casting, and choosing guides. He has the contact information for several great guides and will share those with you. Jerry talked about the dangers of fishing in this area being interactions with allegators, crocodiles, snakes, and sharks. But, he maintains, the biggest danger is the sun! Cover yourself with light clothing, wear good sun glasses, and try not to leave any exposed skin! He talked about hooking into a seagull and narrowly escaping an interaction with a shark. He provided advice to construct leaders with heavy mono and a "shock cord" section of 25 lb. test fluorocarbon to protect your line against sharp teeth.
